

## **UMC** denomination proposal

Many of you, I'm sure, have seen media reports of a newly announced proposal that will be heading to General Conference 2020 to split the United Methodist Church into two or more denominations. Bishop Jeremiah Park of our Susquehanna Conference issued a press release to our churches earlier this month that a Mediation Team representing the Council of Bishops and diverse advocacy groups have released a document entitled "Protocol of Reconciliation and Grace Through Separation."


Under the plan a new Traditionalist denomination would form that would retain our current Discipline and current language on issues of human sexuality and gender. The post-split of the United Methodist Church would then eliminate what is deemed the restrictive language in the Discipline. Each Annual Conference and ultimately each local church will have the opportunity to decide to remain in the current denomination or join the Traditionalist denomination or another new denomination.

A few thoughts here. First of all, this is a proposal of a plan.

Nothing has been decided yet. Nothing has changed. This plan will be considered and voted upon this May at General Conference in Minneapolis. The plan is not a finished product and so we can expect changes and amendments to the plan, even if it is



approved. This plan was formulated by a mediation team with representation from a diversity of groups within the United Methodist Church. Though the plan is probably not anyone's perfect plan, there is a hopefulness here that it honors the main concerns of the diversity of theology and experience in our Church. There is certainly a sadness here, as Bishop Park notes, but there is a hope that we can move forward in an amicable and graceful way and avoid the rancor and legal battles that have accompanied divisions in other denominations.

There will be a lot for us to talk about at Hicks in the coming months. For now I would join with our Bishop in calling us to pray for the United Methodist Church, pray for General Conference this May, and pray for Hicks Church as we seek to discern God's plan for our future. If I can answer any questions for you or if you would just like to share your thoughts with me at this point; I would be happy to do that with you.

Whatever happens in this year of change, may we stay faithful to God as we seek to Make Disciples of Jesus and Create Community.

The total received for the Dove Tree was \$220.



#### New Kitchen Class Study: "The Walk"



How do we walk with Christ – daily follow him, grow in him, and faithfully serve him? In the Gospels, Jesus modeled for us the Christian spiritual life. The apostles taught it in their writings. And the Church has, through the last 2000 years, sought to pursue this Christian spiritual life.

In the Walk, Adam Hamilton focuses on five essential spiritual practices that are rooted in Jesus, own walk with God and taught throughout the New Testament. Each of these practices is a part of our daily walk with Christ and an essential part of growing together in the Church.

Hamilton explores each of these practices, their New Testament foundation, and what it looks like to pursue them daily in our personal lives and together in the life of the Church.

The Kitchen Class meets each Sunday Morning at 9:30 downstairs in the Social Hall of the Church Building. Take the back stairs or elevator downstairs to the Basement. From the stairs take a left into the side hall and enter the classroom through the Kitchen at the end of the Hall. From the Elevator the Kitchen Hall is straight ahead to the left [at the stair doors].
